When our grandparents visited us, Tony was there.

I have wondered about this: of the 12 children born to Anton and Magdalena Baumgartner, why was Tony the one to stay home? How did that election take place? He wasn't the oldest. He wasn't the youngest. Was it just happenstance, or was there something intentional about this even if subconscious?

Here is the reality: Tony did more for his parents than all his siblings combined, including my father. He gladly cared for them and for their home. He never once complained and was always happy. My grandfather lost a leg due to diabetes. Tony cared for him. Grandma had psoriasis on her scalp. Tony smeared the ointment to ease the itching and pain. Laundry—he did it. He painted the interior of the house every five years. He grew the vegetables and canned them. He baked the bread and buttered the toast. In the end, he took the lead in the funeral arrangements for both his parents and then discovered a life without them.

In your family, have you been chosen to care for your parents? It seems like someone always is. You do the bulk of the work and errands. You do a thousand things nobody knows, and nobody thanks you. If you have been chosen, stop and thank God for the singular opportunity to fulfill God's design that we honor our
