Here is a thought from last week's homily, *ADMG, to the greater glory of God.*

There is a lot going on in the church and the news will not let up any time soon. A few people have asked the parish to host "listening sessions." I have been thinking about this for weeks. Rather than the parish hosting any sort of listening session, I am willing to come to your home for conversation. You can invite family and friends; arrange a time, and we will gather to talk through whatever is on your mind. Generally, I am available Saturday afternoons and evenings after 7:00 PM and Sunday afternoons. I am often available on Fridays and some Tuesday evenings. If you want to talk, give me a call or send me a text (218-308-1296). If you text, don't forget to tell me who you are!

At my uncle Tony's (Anton) funeral, I learned that my father had changed his name. He was born and baptized "Edward Anton." His father was Anton. I have always known him as "Edward Joseph." In fact, most of his friends called him "EJ." I have a brother who is Edward Joseph, Junior. We him "JR." My bother Daniel was baptized "Daniel Edward." He has complained his whole life that he would rather have been "Daniel Joseph" so that he could be called "DJ," which are my initials. And so, a mystery is born: Why did my father change his name?

We asked Mom about this on the way home from the funeral. She confirmed that before they met, Dad had changed his name. And he just didn't go by another name; he legally changed his name. Why? She didn't know. If she knew, she didn't say.

A brother wondered if there was a family feud that got so out of hand that Dad needed to change his name. That is the kind of speculation that serves little purpose. Even if he's on to something, I say we let them rest in peace. That goes for the living as well. Speculation and gossip are cousins whose names are nearly interchangeable. Without them, we have a greater chance of living in peace.
