Here is a thought from last week's homily: *When our hearts are too far from Jesus, it is then that we want to take the law into our own hands. We want to determine justice and we want to withhold mercy and love.*

The home of my paternal grandparents was put up for sale a few weeks ago. My uncle Anton lived in the home. He died on October 14. He was a bachelor. What could be done with home besides sell it? It is listed for \$30,000.

It is a two-story home. There is barely a basement, which holds the furnace, water heater and the home-canned goods. There is a bedroom on the first floor. The quirky thing about the house—it is a two-story home with four bedrooms upstairs, and the only way to access the up-stairs is THROUGH the only bathroom.

As a kid I remember being stranded at the bottom of the stairs for what seemed like hours while someone bathed. It was probably 10 minutes, but it seemed like hours.

My grandmother did not speak English and grandpa spoke just a little. German was the language of the home. My dad was very clear that it was "low" German and not "high" German. He wanted to be clear about the family social status. We are simple people who came from simple people.

The home smelled like moth balls. They painted every wall in the interior every five years. Every room was white. My dad thought that with painting so often they would eventually diminish the square footage of the house. It is listed as 624 square foot on the main floor—at one time it must have been 625.

When I saw the listing, my heart sank. The house is sold furnished and looks exactly like it did when I was born in 1963, and when we visited in 1973, and when Grandma died in 1988, and when mom and I were there last year to see Uncle Tony.

Our hearts sink for lots of reasons: generations pass, memories fade, we cannot visit the past, we regret things we did and things we didn't do. When my dad died, a brother and I were talking about our relationship with Dad. My brother looked at me and said, "I have no regrets...except for not kissing him on the cheek as he did for his dad." My brother kissed our daddy in his casket. No regrets.
