The missionary, Brendan Case, told a beautiful story at our parish mission this past week about an encounter with a woman in a gas station in Detroit Lakes. She stood staring blankly into an aisle at a convenience store. He asked her if she was OK. She shared a story that began like this, "Today is the first anniversary of my husband's death..." In a convenience store, he took her hand, and they prayed.

Every day of the week I see people I don't know. Today I noted a man in a restaurant. He was young and wearing a long wool coat that may have belonged to his great-grandfather. I saw a woman behind a desk in a funeral home. I noticed a man walking with a limp in a parking lot. I enjoyed the service of the waitstaff for my lunch hotdog.

I am aware of the difference in how I engage people and how a missionary engages people. I noted. I saw. I enjoyed... The missionary encountered.

Our Lord must tire of plopping us right in front of opportunities to comfort and console, to share his word and a prayer, and all we do is pay for our gas.
