Here is a thought from last week's homily: *God has many different ways of finding us and even turning our wrong ways into right ways.*

Last week one of my brothers was looking for the recipe for our mother's turkey hot dish. Another brother was looking for VCR tapes that were last seen in the basement of our parent's home in a cabinet next to the TV...three houses ago. I would like to find my high school class ring which I lost in Moorhead in 1982.

I am sure that the hot dish had no recipe. It was some combination of onions, rice, turkey and a creamed soup. We can be nostalgic about something that was always spontaneous and never repeatable. To resolve this craving, we can be creative in the kitchen while sharing stories of family and times past.

It seems like a full-time job to maintain the record of our lives. The first movies taken of my family were 8mm reels. These were converted to VCR tapes, which may have been burned onto a CD, which might now exist somewhere on a cloud of information...somewhere out there.

I remember the first computer I had in seminary. It stored information in a cassette tape with poor success. I ripped my hair out more than once when the data was lost. And then instead of writing a "new" paper, I tried to recreate the one that I had already written but lost. For me it was much harder to remember what I said in contrast to saying it again with fresh words.

As for my class ring, I gave up the search when I bought a new one. But it still kind of hurts that the original was lost. What would be healed or satisfied if the ring appeared on my desk tomorrow? If the recipe that never was came into being? If the VCR tape was recovered?

The constant challenge is for us to be present to the present moment. The meal will more likely satisfy if you are not drifting into the future wondering how you will recreate the yummy dish of the past. Your laugh will be heartier and your tears sweeter if give yourself to the moment without the mediation of the camera on your phone.

Right now, I am going to dig out my new class ring and wear it as I struggle to recreate my mother's meatballs.
