Here is a thought from last week's homily: *To each has been given a manifestation of the Holy Spirit for some benefit.*

I am still pondering last week's gospel, the story of the wedding feast at Cana. I can hardly imagine the sight of 150 gallons of wine. We buy wine for the Church in gallon bottles, four in a case. We are talking about 37+ cases of wine. This super abundance of wine is a sign of God's desire to be generous with us. God wants us to have what we need and not just enough to barely eke by.

I have a friend who loves to be generous. The world would be so blessed if she ever won the lottery. Her greatest desire is to give. She sees someone in a food court, and she wants to buy his meal. She sees a young mother at a check out, and she wants to buy her groceries. From a beggar on a street corner to an old man in a park, she wants to give to each person what is needed. God wants this for all of his children.

That's it! A daddy wants to give to his children what they need. He withholds from us nothing. All the while we can be like hungry dogs fighting for a scrap of food. My desire to have gets in the way of God's desire to give.

I remember a priest preaching about generosity in my childhood. He said, "Nobody should eat cake until everyone eats bread." I was confused by that because the priest had a substantial appetite for sweets. Still, it is a good saying. Jesus not only turned water into wine, but he multiplied the loaves. Invite him into your heart, ask him to make you more generous each day. This gives God permission to bless us even more.
