Here is a thought from last week's homily: *Son, why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety.*

Thank you for the kind Christmas prayers, greetings, invitations and gifts. I appreciate your thoughtfulness very much.

I watched a little girl come forward for the children's collection. She navigated the step on the way up, but on the way down she had to think hard about it. She stopped. She considered the distance. She even nudged a toe over the edge. She decided to sit down, hang her legs over the edge, and with feet firmly planted on the lower level, she stood up, gained her balance and trotted away. It was her caution, her ability to think before she leapt, that caught my eye.

Sometimes we struggle to be as intentional in our deliberations. A thoughtless leap can land us in all sorts of trouble: relationship, financial, spiritual, et cetera. A leap can be out of habit—I have done it a hundred times; I can do it again. It can be an addiction—I thought I would have enough money for both gambling and rent. It can be a mistake—I regretted it before my feet hit the ground. I am left pondering whether we are willing to support one another in the leaps of life, even when they lack prudence.

In my heart of hearts, I was hoping the little girl would jump! I wanted her to be brave. I wanted her to test gravity and discover that success is sweet and failure doesn't hurt too much. I am much less enthusiastic and charitable when bigger people jump. When we fall, we break a hip, the bank or the hearts of our loved ones. Prudence is spiritual gift—it is to see life and the consequences of our choices from God's perspective before we commit. When we lack prudence, what we really need is a second chance and sometimes healthcare. God tolerates our childish ways. Let us put on kindness and mercy for 2019.
