During the winter months, if school is either cancelled or 2 hours late, Adoration will be cancelled.

Here is a thought from last week's homily: *Would any of these words make you a new person? Love is patient. Love is kind. Love is not rude. Love does not brood over injuries. Love endures all things.*

During the children's collection last Sunday, a child presented me with a dollar bill and said, "I got this from the Tooth Fairy last night." Then she pointed to the spot where there was a tooth missing.

I remember the Tooth Fairy at work in my family's home. Over the course of twenty years there was always a child of tooth-losing age. I remember a quarter under my pillow. I remember planning what I would do with it. My plans always included a trip to the variety store which had a penny candy counter. Twenty-five cents was equivalent to TWENTY FIVE pieces of candy! Then there was always the chance that I would find a few pennies on the street as I traveled to the store.

I came to a sense of stewardship in my teenage years. I understood from the example of my parents that I was to share my money with the Church. Some years later I broadened this to an idea of a tithe, with a portion going to the Church and a portion going directly to the poor. How fortunate we are to have a child in our midst that considers the Church and the poor over her own desires. She gave not a dime or even a quarter, but the whole dollar.

The next time you see a smile with a missing tooth, smile back, and remember that that little heart may have much to teach you about generosity and gratitude.
