I was sick the week of Holy Week—it was an uncommon cold. I was in bed for three days. I was reminded of how hard it is to pray when I am sick. I had time on my hands but didn't even pray my normal prayers. Normally, I don't ask myself if I "feel" like praying. When it is time to pray, I pray whether I feel like it or not. It is different when I am sick.

Someone observed that we become self-centered when we are sick. Most of the time our bodies cooperate with our spirits. Our bodies serve us with little or no complaint. In our bodies we work and play and pray. When we are well, we simply take for granted that we are physically capable of doing what we want to do. Not when we are sick.

When we are sick, our bodies demand attention. "I can't breathe!" scream the lungs. "I hurt!" scream our head and every limb. This corporeal self-centeredness makes prayer a special challenge.

The elderly, sick and injured rise to a new level of holiness when they pray. They are truly stepping out of themselves and into the presence of the Lord. Most days I can pray because I feel well. We pray for love of the Lord. Others pray for us because they love us.
