Here is a thought from last week's homily, *When Jesus shows us his hands and his side, it is an invitation to show him our wounds.*

The first person I baptized was my nephew Jake. His wife organized a surprise party for him last Saturday, for his 30<sup>th</sup> birthday. For the last eleven years he has worked in the oil fields in Western North Dakota. His schedule was demanding—two weeks on and one week off. With two little boys at home, it was time for the next chapter in his employment. He has a new job closer to home.

Closer to home. I have an uncle who lived in Florida for 40+ years. When he turned 90 he decided he wanted to be closer to home. He and his wife moved from their home in Florida into a small apartment in a small town in Western North Dakota, about 20 miles from farm on which he was born.

An older brother lived in Houston, TX. When he retired, he wanted to live in Minnesota, close to his home. His wife wanted to live in Denver, which was her home. Since they could not agree they decided to split the difference and settled in Rapid City, SD.

The place of our birth, the house of our childhood, the cemetery that contains the remains of our parents; for many these contribute to the definition of home. When I miss the walks around town and the merchants of my childhood, I close my eyes and pray. When I pray am closer to home. When we gather together to praise and thank God, we are closer to home. When I imagine Jesus opening the gates of heaven I feel the draw of home.
