

Here is a thought from last week's homily: *We cannot let troubles rule us. We rule them, and in doing so we will experience the Risen Jesus.*

Here is a true story.

Fr. Andrew was standing outside the small hospital in rural Uganda. A mother with her 10-year-old daughter passed by. The daughter was weak and pale.

They were in the hospital for only a few minutes. As they left the building Fr. Andrew learned that the daughter needed a blood transfusion and the hospital did not have her blood type. They were referred to a hospital an hour and a half away. They had no car and no money.

Fr. Andrew helped the mother and her daughter into his car with the intention of getting her help. A half hour into the trip the little girl died.

When Fr. Andrew told me this story there were tears in his eyes. He cried for the little girl and for her mommy and for the countless other children that died in Uganda that day. In Uganda these scenes play out every day. There was nothing exceptional about a child dying—for lack of nutrition, routine health care, clean water, safe shelter, aides...

I am frozen in the face of this story. It is not merely a matter of changing a few hearts to save a few people. A pressing need exists to assist an entire nation develop, without threat to its identity. I want to conclude that this is beyond my pay grade. It is not beyond our prayer grade. Pray hard. The world needs prayers. And if we can save only one child, then we had better get to it.
