Here is a thought from last week's homily: *People offend us. They make choices that are bad or even evil. Our hearts shrink up and we convince ourselves that there is no room for repentance and forgiveness, for love and new life. Jesus did not do this. He never stopped inviting people into his life.*

Are you busy? My mother ran a household for 13 people. There was no end to the cooking, baking, laundry and cleaning. How did she keep track of the household calendar? On top of this she could be called to the hospital for a delivery or to assist with a surgery at any time. Any day of the week at any hour of the day someone could have asked Mom, "Are you busy?" She could have said, "Of course I am busy! Look at the pile of laundry five feet high! Look at the clock; it is 5:43 PM and dinner needs to be on the table in 17 minutes. Are you crazy? Of course I am busy!" She could have said this. She could have looked into the little eyes of the beggar at her feet and said, "Of course not. What do you need?"

Sometimes we have to stop and look into the eyes of the person near us. We need to consider what in the world could be more important than the personal encounter that might happen if I say "No. Of course not. I am not busy." How often is a person changed, mended, encouraged or affirmed because you made a moment of time?

Are you busy? Sure I have things to do...but none of them are more important than you.
