*On July 22, 2020, Gov. Tim Walz issued executive order 20-81, which mandates the use of face coverings in all indoor spaces, including churches, but with some exceptions. It takes effect on Saturday, July 25. Though decisions regarding safety protocols within Catholic churches are ultimately within the authority of the diocesan bishop, the Church can and should collaborate with public officials in the service of public health and the common good unless public health directives are terribly unreasonable, impractical, or discriminatory. The Diocese of Crookston does not view the request to wear face coverings indoors as unreasonable. We recognize that parishes have already instituted strict social distancing and cleanliness protocols, and this mask requirement is an additional burden. We appreciate your flexibility to promote community health. Please note liturgical ministers such as priest celebrants, cantors, and lectors are exempt from Gov. Walz's order and are not required to have face coverings when lecturing, singing, or celebrating Mass.*

**Safe Environment 2020/21**

It is time to renew Safe Environment Certifications. If you work/volunteer in any capacity for Sacred Heart Parish with either youth or vulnerable adults, this certification is required by the Diocese every year. Go to: <http://www.crookston.org/secertification> to complete your certification online. If you do not do it online, get a hard copy of the information in the kiosk in the vestibule. Please everybody get this done by August 31. There is a fair amount of bookkeeping in keeping track of who needs to/has completed the Safe Environment requirement; this bookkeeping is much easier if everyone gets this done by August 31.
