Here is a thought from last week's homily: *In their hearts the disciples had already concluded what Jesus verbalized for them: she is a Gentile dog, not worthy of their time, their mercy, or the good news of the Kingdom of God.*

There are about 15 baby evergreen trees in the rectory yard. All of them were transplanted here as saplings. At first they were so small, the grass could be taller than them. Each one had the a utility flag to mark its existence. Like buried piles and lines, they could be inadvertently injured or destroyed.

Today some of them are 30 inches tall. They no longer need little flags to avert the mower. A few years has made a big difference. I can hardly imagine what they will look like in 10 years.

We can be impatient with the faith of those who are precious to us. They are still saplings and we want them to be towering and strong like the cedars of Lebanon. For some, the years pass and it seems like there is no growth at all.

I have found that hollering at the trees produces nothing good, nor is there any benefit from shaming them for being weak. I do what I can to keep them safe. They are watered and weeded. Growth is up to them. I don't like this. I want them to be ten feet tall by my command.

What is in the mind of God when he looks at us? Are we as tall and strong as we can be? Probably not. We may be the sapling and we don't even know it. God says, "I will nurture him with patience; I will give her another year to bear fruit."
