Here is a though from last week's homily: *Ask for the apple, don't steal. If God denies us something, it is because God has a better gift.*

How long should we live with the imperfect?

My scooter has a leaky gas tank. I tried to fix it myself. I watched every do-it-yourself video available. A hundred times I talked myself into just living with it. For an unknown reason, I cracked last week. After three years of filling the tank only half full, wiping up gas from the garage floor and smelling fumes even in the kitchen, I decided to bring it to a cycle shop. Enough is enough.

Does this story change at all if I am talking about the imperfections in another person? What if I am the imperfect person that causes others to be aggravated?

Living with others (and working with them and playing with them) ought to polish our rough edges. We notice when we are annoying, and we should want to do something about it. Why would I want the people I love to be annoyed or discouraged by my behavior when I can change it?

If I can change and I don't, it is a lack of charity and it presumes too much on the charity of others.

When I get my scooter back, I wonder if I will think, "Why didn't I do that sooner?" Don't let your spouse, family or friends wait on you a single day longer.
