Don't tell her, but I am thinking about arranging for a new chair for my mother. The chair she sits in most often is a burgundy recliner. It is about 20 years old. It looks good, but like a luke-warm friend, it is lacking support. Here is my dilemma: my brother wants to get her a new mattress, but she doesn't want a new mattress. She sleeps well and never gets up with pain. Is my thought of a new chair like this? I think she needs one...but I haven't bothered to ask her.

We often have good intentions regarding those we love. We see something they may need or enjoy, and we presume to know their minds. Sometimes, in charity, we do what does not need to be done.

Even as I think of asking her, I am more inclined to sell her on the idea. It is the mattress all over again!

Generosity needs to include the authentic needs and firmly held desires of the person. Anything else is self-centered and condescending. Ask. Respect. Love always.
