Here is a thought from a letter in last week's homily: *"I am eternally grateful for my parents' wisdom and guidance, for my sister Sarah and for my son, Abel. I feel comforted knowing that he is "abel" to be with Sarah and Jesus in Heaven."*

Generosity needs to include the authentic needs and firmly held desires of the person. Anything else is self-centered and condescending. Ask. Respect. Love always.


