Here is a thought from last week's homily: *They who pray with faith have fervor, and fervor is the fire of prayer. This mysterious fire has the power of consuming all our faults and imperfections, and of giving to our actions vitality, beauty and merit. (Mother Cabrini)*

I am amazed at the expertise people hold, and you don't have to look far to find it. A pharmacist can answer questions about drug interaction, and a parts man can answer questions about motor oil and fuel lines. I met a man who knows everything about antique tractors. It would take me long to find someone expert in modern tractors and the GPS that drives them. Teachers have a command of their subject matter and musicians know music. It is truly amazing!

Faith is born of a personal relationship—most of the time with a parent. “With parents leading the way by example and family prayer, their children—indeed, all within the family circle—will find it easier to make progress in natural virtues, in salvation and in holiness.” (*Gaudium et spes*, n. 48)

Parents seldom feel like experts in the faith. Remember that faith the size of a mustard seed can move mountains. Your faith is enough for you to show your children love and patience, for you to teach them life skills and special skills. What you lack can be provided by others. There are people near you who complement your deficiencies. Invite them into the circle of grace.
