Here is a thought from last week's homily: At the call of Jesus, Simon and Andrew abandoned their nets. They did not put them into storage in case they would need them later.

Last week I wrote a letter to someone about something. (It was none of you!) It was the culmination of a few months about stewing. To write a letter can be good therapy. Writing helps us organize our thoughts, solidify them and purify them. Now I need to beg the Holy Spirit to give me guidance. Just because my feelings are strong and are now thoughts in ink on a page does not mean that I should mail the letter.

This exercise is also a chance for me to monitor my charity. Strong feelings (like anger, disappointment, disillusionment) do not give us license to be uncharitable or unreasonable. Sometimes in anger a response can be disproportionate. We think it will feel good to get even or to have the last word.

Are you stewing about anything? Do you want to rattle some cages and humiliate the person who offends you? Go ahead; write a letter. Then pray long and hard about whether you should send it. And put-on empathy. Try to understand the other point of view. Remember: Nothing feels good without Jesus or without love, the pursuit of justice and mercy.
