You may have figured out from last week's homily that I am reading a book on alcoholism and recovery. I would like to share a summary of steps 4-9, which is an apt description of the repentance we seek in the season of Lent.

"The fourth step inventory presents a "once-in-a-lifetime" opportunity to pause in your daily life of coping with the tyranny of the urgent to peer carefully back at every situation that caused you to evolve into the person you have become. Few people ever have the chance to take responsibility for what they have done or not done with their life in the middle of it! Responsibility is the exact opposite of blame.
