*Here is a thought from last week's homily, Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have this bread to offer.*

*We are to be salt and light for the world. We accomplish this by living the beatitudes—not merely for ourselves, but so that people can see faith in action and be inspired to give glory to God.*

*Salt seasons and preserves. It is as if God wants to give us a life that is tasty and enduring. For many, life isn't so tasty. In fact, it's more like dry, stale toast. This is not what God intends for us. We are to be nourished by the food we eat and the friends we keep. God wants moments in our lives to be so great that we savor them, and for them to be not too far apart.*

*Light is what God wants us to be for those who live in darkness. People live the painful loss of loved ones and once possible dreams. People live with worries that are oppressive. People live with sadness and sin, with brokenness and being alone. For them we are to be the light. We can be a light that brings hope when someone gives up on hope.*

*To be salt and light is our vocation. It is our privilege and our joy.*
