 If you would like to help with CBS let Christine know before June 20th. We need 5 Adults and 6 older youth to help make CBS successful.

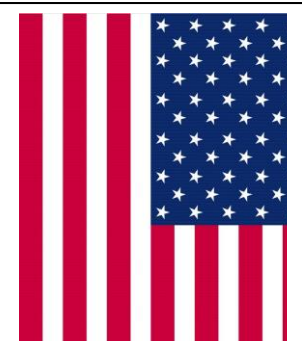
