Misery meets Mercy

John 20:1-18

“...she turned around and saw Jesus” (V. 14)

During World War II, a painting of the risen Christ with Mary Magdalene, *Noli me Tangere*, by the sixteenth-century artist Titian, was London’s most treasured picture. For a month in 1942 it was, by public demand, the sole painting on display in the National Gallery when thousands had been removed to Welsh slate mines for safekeeping. It was cherished because as the bombs fell, Londoners found reassurance in this story that love is so strong that it can survive death.

The resurrection appearances of Jesus have the ring of truth about them because they are so downbeat. Hollywood film directors scripting this turning point in the whole of Western civilization would devise a scene in which superhuman hands toppled the tombstone while the enemies of Jesus staggered back aghast. Resurrection came with the whisper of a name and a message of good news.

Jesus’ first appearance after his resurrection was to Mary Magdalene. She was a woman who had lost her way through life and then found calm and purpose when she followed Jesus. She was a forgiven sinner. She was a person who, on that Sunday morning, was demoralized and in distress. And she was someone whose evidence had every likelihood of being dismissed in the male-dominated culture of the day.

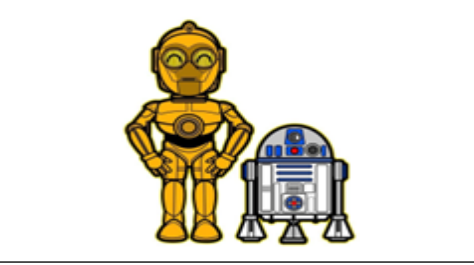
