

Father Hamness is on vacation Monday May 22nd to Saturday morning May 27th.

You may be reading this because you are interested in exploring the vocation of a permanent deacon. The next formation group will begin in the Fall of 2024. From Fall 2023 through Winter 2024, the Diocese will host a number of "Discerning the Diaconate" sessions around the Diocese for men, and spouses if married, so that they can find out more about the program. You are also strongly encouraged to talk with your pastor as well as deacons you may already know.
