Father Hamness is on vacation Monday May 22nd to Saturday morning May 27th. Also Monday June 5th to Saturday morning June 10th.

Sunday June 11th is the celebration of both Corpus Christi and Father Hamness's 10-year ordination of the priesthood. Please join us for Mass at 10am followed by a procession of the Blessed Sacrament, Benediction, and a gathering celebration with a potluck. **EVERYONE** is welcome!!!!!!

"As the Father has sent me, so I send you."
 Possibly, this verse should be called the great commission. Following the resurrection, we are sent, as the Father sent his Son. We are to participate intimately in God's activity, in the Trinity's very nature. But what does this imply? In today's passage, Jesus says "Peace be with you" twice, an exhortation he repeats for a third time a week later, this time with Thomas present. Peace, *shalom*, is the nature of the triune God. This is not peace in a political or economic sense; the disciples will go on to face persecution. The peace of the Father and Son is the peace of forgiveness and wholeness. It is also a peace that we offer to others by being their servant, as Christ was the servant of many. We are sent, as was Christ, metaphorically and literally to empty ourselves and wash feet. The peace we proclaim is likely to become increasingly vital in our society, which is facing economic and structural transition.

Re-creation is also present in today's passage. The Holy Spirit is given to the disciples by Jesus breathing over them. This recalls the wind, breath or Spirit of God moving over the face of the waters at the beginning of creation. Life came forth then, just as new life is now experienced in the risen Christ. Go and do likewise.

- 10. If Jesus were actually visible in church, everyone would run to welcome Him, but He remains hidden in the Sacred Host under the appearance of Bread, because He is calling us to faith, that we many come to Him in humility.**
 "The Blessed Sacrament is the "Living Heart" of each of our churches and it is our very sweet duty to honor and adore the Blessed Host, which our eyes see, the Incarnate Word, Whom they cannot see." (Pope Paul VI, Credo of the People of God)
- 11. With transforming mercy, Jesus makes our heart one with His.**
 "He proposes His own example to those who come to Him, that all may learn to be like Himself, gentle and humble of heart, and to seek not their own interest but those of God." (Pope Paul VI, Mysterium Fidei)
- 12. If the Pope himself would give you a special invitation to visit him in the Vatican, this honor would be nothing in comparison to the honor and dignity that Jesus Himself bestows upon you with the Invitation of spending one hour with Him in the Blessed Sacrament.**
