Father Hamness is on vacation Monday June 5<sup>th</sup> to Saturday morning June 10<sup>th</sup>.

Sunday June 11<sup>th</sup> is the celebration of both Corpus Christi and Father Hamness's 10-year ordination of the priesthood. Please join us for Mass at 10am followed by a procession of the Blessed Sacrament, Benediction, and a gathering celebration with a potluck. EVERYONE is welcome!!!!

Today our focus is on the Holy Trinity: One God, in three persons. This is hard for humans to understand, in fact it seems incomprehensible to us. How can something be one and three at the same time. It seems like a logical contradiction. God alone can understand it. Christians have refined statements about our belief in the Trinity over the centuries, but what we are able to say about the Trinity is generally not focused on what the Trinity is, but rather it is focused on what we know that the Triune God is not, based on Scripture and Tradition. For the most part, we've resorted to images to explain the Holy Trinity to the average person. Here are a few of those kinds of images and symbols.

St. Patrick used a Shamrock when teaching about the Trinity to the People of Ireland. In Gothic architecture, certain elements indicated our belief in the Triune God. Consider this stone tracery in the window of a Gothic Church.



Finally, here is a diagram that attempts to summarize the Holy Trinity and how each person of the Trinity is (or is not) related to the other members.
