Safe Environment 2023/2024

It is time to renew Safe Environment Certifications. If you work/volunteer in any capacity for Sacred Heart Parish with either the youth or vulnerable adults, this certification is required by the Diocese every year. Go to: <http://www.crookston.org/secertification> to complete your certification online. If you are unable to go online, Christine Dornbusch will set you up in the office with a laptop. This is a new program that the Diocese is using so please allow ample time to complete it. Please everybody get this done by August 1st. There is a fair amount of bookkeeping in keeping track of who needs to/has completed the Safe Environment requirement; this bookkeeping is much easier if everyone gets this done by **August 1st.**
