As Matthew's predominantly Jewish Christian community struggled with the increasing number of Gentile Christians who were joining them, the evangelist could point to the incident in today's gospel reading and say, see how Jesus himself had to struggle with a Gentile—and see how he recognized her great faith. Not only Matthew's first century community needs to look carefully. It is also our own racism, sexism, and cultural superiority that we see reflected in this gospel. We are challenged to cross boundaries and offer them the crumbs of our compassion.

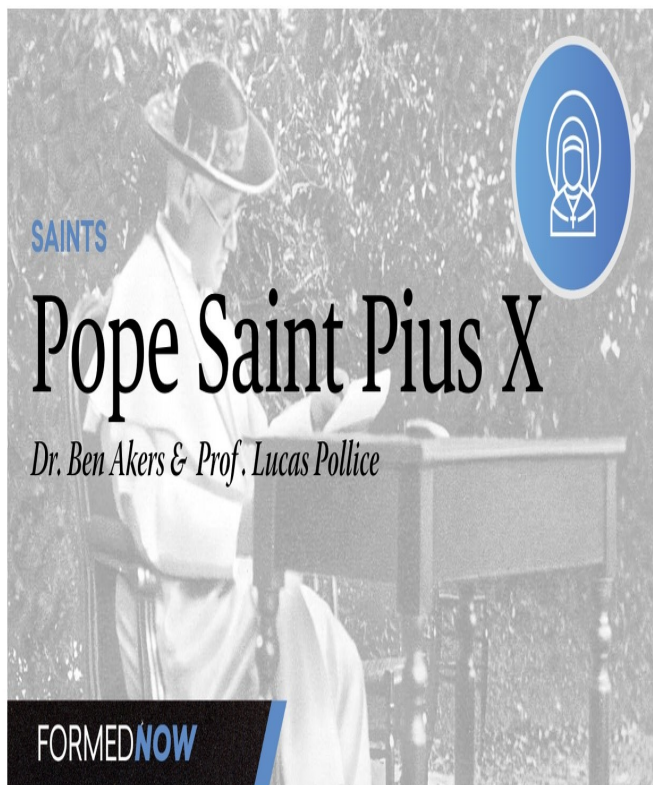
Coffee, snacks and social time.
