Reflections for Sunday Year A

"For John came to you in the way of righteousness and you did not believe him"— Matthew 21:23-43

We might entitle the second half of Matthew 21 as "Jesus and the abominable on-men", because running through these verses is the Lord's impatience and even severity with things and people who fail to fulfil— and even resist and oppose— the purpose for which they are created. Love that is as urgent and real as the love of Jesus rejects everything and everybody who rejects it. This even includes the barren fig tree in the verses just before today's reading. Love mad fig trees to provide figs for hungry people, and they are useless when they don't.

Love gave John the Baptist to call Israel to repentance-and Jesus has no time for theoretical arguments about the source and nature of authority with those who resisted John's saving summons.

It is all summed up in the parable at the end. These two sons could expect starring parts in The Vicar of Dibley! One starts by saying "no, no, no," but repents into acting "yes" while the other starts by saying "yes, yes, yes," but ends by acting "no". On the showing of this passage the latter is in acute danger of experiencing the impatient severity of Jesus, whereas the first son, who turns from "no" to "yes" from resistance to obedience will fine a place in the field where God's abundant harvests grow.


