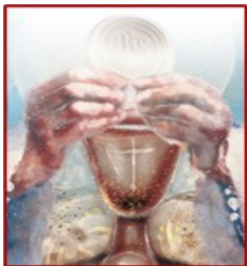
### "Sacred Heart and Assumption

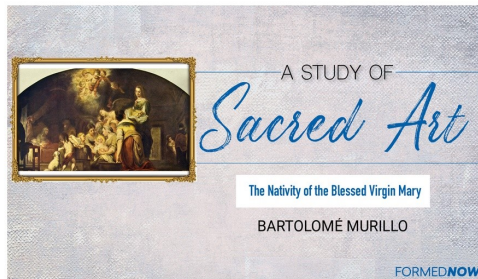
