Elijah didn't sense God in the roaring wind, in the earthquake, or in the raging fire, but he instantly knew that it was God Himself in the tiny, whispering sound. Each portion of Scripture can be understood in several ways and have several meanings, that is why we need the teaching authority of the Church to interpret the Sacred Scriptures for us. One meaning of this passage from the First Book of Kings can be in reference to the human conscience. We hear God in our conscience. At least so long as we have a well-formed conscience, and not a warped conscience. This is a little like how Elijah sensed God in the tiny, whispering sound.
