**Care for the Sick, Homebound, & Bereaved**

You have heard for a few decades now the acronym R.C.I.A. which stood for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. This was the program we have been using to bring someone into the Church, whether the person was never baptized, or whether the person had been baptized in a Protestant denomination and wanted to be received fully into the Catholic Church. Recently the title of this program has changed to the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (O.C.I.A.).

I intend to begin our parish's O.C.I.A. program in November, so I am putting out the call now for anyone who may be interested in joining the Catholic Church, whether unbaptized or someone who was raised in a non-Catholic Christian denomination. Please spread the word that this class/program will be starting soon, and please let me know if you are interested or if you know of someone who is interested. If you're not sure, you are welcome to come and ask questions to help you decide. The beginning stages of this program have no commitment expected. We already have one young man who wishes to be baptized at Easter, and I would be delighted to talk to anyone else to may have an interest. A non-Catholic person might come to Mass for years or decades with a Catholic spouse, but never enter the Church simply because he or she has never been asked. This is me asking you! You are welcome to join us, or just learn more deeply what we believe, and you would be welcome to come to our program sessions. It would be helpful if I knew ahead of time who might
