

Recently the title of this program has changed to the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (O.C.I.A.).

We already have one young man who wishes to be baptized at Easter, and I would be delighted to talk to anyone else to may have an interest. A non -Catholic person might come to Mass for years or decades with a Catholic spouse, but never enter the Church simply because he or she has never been asked. This is me asking you! You are welcome to join us, or just learn more deeply what we believe, and you would be welcome to come to our program sessions. It would be helpful if I knew ahead of time who might be interested, so that I could try to work out a meeting time that could work for most people.
