From the Desk of Fr Hamness:

These past weeks we have been exhorted to believe in the real presences of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Something there has not been time to consider while preaching on Sundays is the phenomenon of Eucharistic Miracles, which are extraordinary events, where the Eucharist no longer appears under the form of bread and wine, but takes on the biological qualities of human flesh or blood or both. These miracles have no scientific explanation but can be scientifically verified, and help us go beyond the visible and perceptible to the existence of something beyond, or even supernatural. A few months ago, during the summer, there was a travelling exhibit at Holy Rosary Church in Detroit Lakes about all of the world's Eucharistic Miracles, which had been put together by a boy who died of leukemia in 2006 at the age of 15. This Italian boy was Blessed Carlo Acutis. His mission was to create a website in many languages that had information about every instance of a Eucharistic world, and Blessed Carlo's website can still be accessed at the following address:

St Martin de Porres (1579-1639)

(Born in Lima, <u>Viceroyalty</u> of <u>Peru</u> [now in Peru]—died November 3, 1639, Lima; canonized 1962; feast day November 3), Peruvian friar noted for his kindness, his nursing of the sick, his obedience, and his charity. He is the patron

saint of social justice, racial harmony, and mixed-race people. His funeral was an occasion of public honor, and many miracles were said to have occurred after his death. He was beatified in 1837 by Pope Gregory XVI and was canonized in 1962 by Pope John XXIII. In art he is often depicted with a broom, which symbolizes his ready willingness to serve others, and with a dog or mouse for his kindness toward animals.
