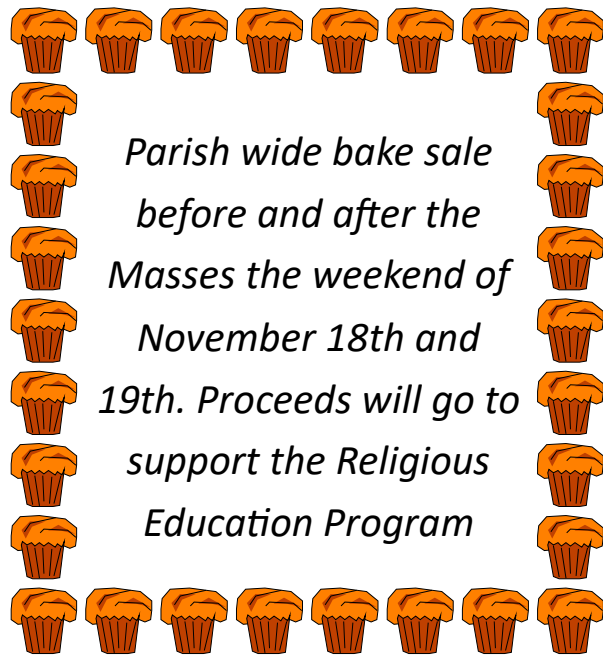

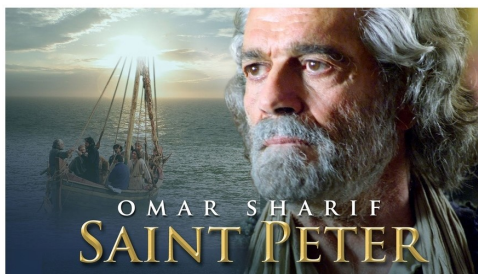
This retreat is focused on understanding the Lord's sacrifice as we enter the Lenten season.

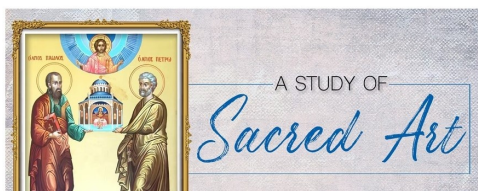
Paul the Apostle | The Bible Collection
