## Care for the Sick, Homebound, & Bereaved

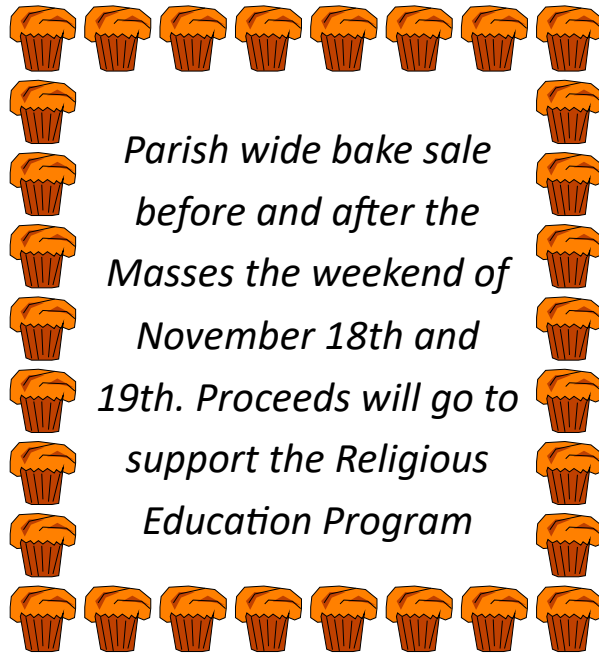

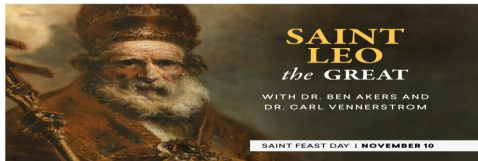

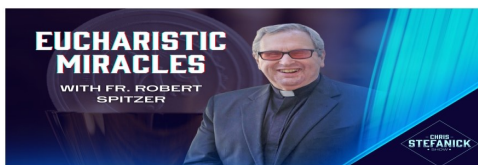
