5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

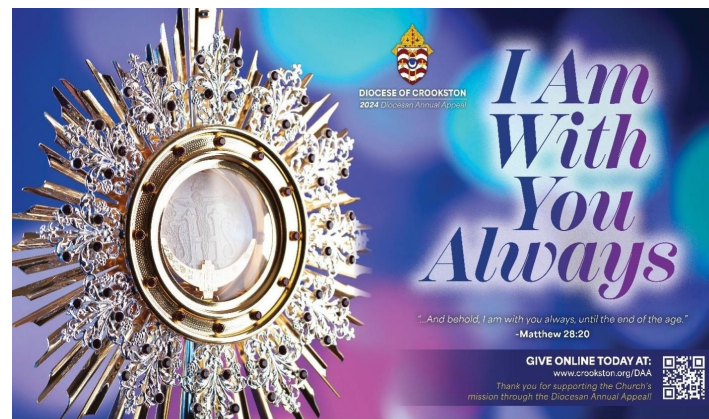
