Passiontide (in the Christian liturgical year) is a name for the last two weeks of Lent, beginning on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, long celebrated as Passion Sunday, and continuing through Lazarus Saturday (i.e. Holy Saturday). It commemorates the suffering of Christ (Latin passio = "suffering"). The second week of Passiontide is Holy Week, ending on Holy Saturday.

In the Roman Catholic Church, all crucifixes and images may be covered in veils (usually violet, the color of vestments in Lent) starting on Passion Sunday: Crosses are to be covered until the end of the celebration of the Lord's passion on Good Friday. Statues and images are to remain covered until just before the Easter Vigil. The veiling was associated with the scene in the Gospel of John (8:46–59) in which Jesus "hid himself" from the people.

The Most Reverend Andrew H. Cozzens invites all the faithful of the Diocese of Crookston to the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception for the 2024 Chrism Mass at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, March 25. Each year, the oils for sacramental anointing used in the diocese are blessed at the Chrism Mass. These oils include: the oil of the infirm, used for the sick and dying to give them strength to bear their suffering, resist evil and obtain forgiveness for sin; the oil of the catechumens, used to give strength to renounce sin and the devil; and the Sacred Chrism, the chief anointing oil, used at Baptism, Confirmation and Ordination as well as the anointing of altars and walls of churches being dedicated for Christian worship. Representatives will receive the blessed oils and take them to their parishes throughout the diocese. The priests of the diocese will also renew their promises to the bishop that evening. 
