“I am the good shepherd”

What makes Jesus the “good” shepherd? This passage make the answer clear. He cares for his sheep in a way that a hired helper wouldn’t understand. He knows, loves and protects his sheep and even lays down his life for them. Every Christian can pray the opening words of Psalm 23 with confidence: The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

Jesus also says here that his sheep know him. One of the things that people recognize as belonging to a shepherd is a shepherd’s crook. Bishops carry one too as a sign of their pastoral vocation. Because of the curved end of the crook. It’s usual to think that they are primarily used for reaching out and grabbing sheep around neck, hauling them back in when being too independent or naughty. A Shropshire farmer once corrected this image for me. He said the crook was really for sticking deeply into the ground so that he could hold himself so still the sheep eventually began to trust him.

This has many implications for bishops, and for all of us, as to what it is that establishes within us what is trustworthy and true. The rooted stillness of prayer and attention is where our compassion and responsibilities must all start. It is that same rootedness in the love of his Father that draws us the Christ. His voice, with its words of life, is a part of that divine magnetism of mystery that brings peace to the human soul.—Reflection by Mark Oakley—Reflections for Sundays year B by Paula Gooder

When you pray, do you only ask Jesus for the things that you want? Do you ever ask Jesus what He wants from you? How do you listen for His response? Many times Jesus responds in "quiet whispers" that are not so obvious. So, take time every day, in silence, to actively listen for His voice.

Liturgy of the Hours: Week IV of the Psalter
Reflection on the Gospel
 Some worry that today's gospel implies that disciples are basically dumb sheep, easily led by deception. But is the gospel implying this? The metaphor falters when we notice that it emphasizes the intimate knowledge the sheep have of the shepherd and vice versa(10:14). Indeed, in the vocabulary of the Bible, "to know" another oftentimes refers to sexual intimacy. Moreover, the intimacy between Jesus and "his own" reflects the relationship he has with the Father (10:15). It is an intimacy that is expressed ultimately in loving self-surrender, even unto death.
