In the mid-1200s a holy woman named Juliana was receiving heavenly visions that there should be a feast day in honor of the Most Holy Eucharist, outside of Lent. Of course, the original (and most important) day in honor of the Blessed Sacrament is the day of its institution, Holy Thursday, and we do have ceremonies acknowledging that, but it is at a somber time of year. Juliana was receiving visions from God suggesting that it would be most fitting to have a celebration in honor of the Holy Eucharist at a time outside of Lent so that it could take on a joyful character. Meanwhile, Saint Thomas Aquinas was writing about the Sacraments and coming to similar conclusions, and he was petitioning the pope to establish just such a feast day. In 1265 the feast of Corpus Christi was, indeed, established, and we are celebrating this mystery of our faith today.

After the 12:15 Mass in Frazee, there will be a brief Eucharistic procession, and everyone is welcome to join in, no matter which Mass you went to this weekend, and no matter at which church. If you would like to come, I would guess that you should arrive at Sacred Heart Church around 1:00 p.m. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will begin after Communion at the Latin Mass, we'll pray in silence for a few minutes, and then we will walk in procession around the parish property, and finish up in the Church with Benediction!


The Triumph of the Immaculate Heart
