"Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves" (v31)

Safe Environment 2024/2025



This is a new program that the Diocese is using so please allow ample time to complete it. Please everybody get this done by August 1st. There is a fair amount of bookkeeping in keeping track of who needs to/ has completed the Safe Environment requirement; this bookkeeping is much easier if everyone gets this done by **August 1st.**
