Mark 6:30-34, 53-end

“Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves” (v31)

Christian discipleship and ministry can be prone to high levels of guilt and exhaustion. It is to do with our expectation. Are we doing enough for God? The task is endless. The challenges are huge. And what is ever enough for God? So for some of us at least, a story of Jesus trying to arrange a few days off for his disciples because they are tired may come as merciful reversal of our assumptions about what God expects of us. 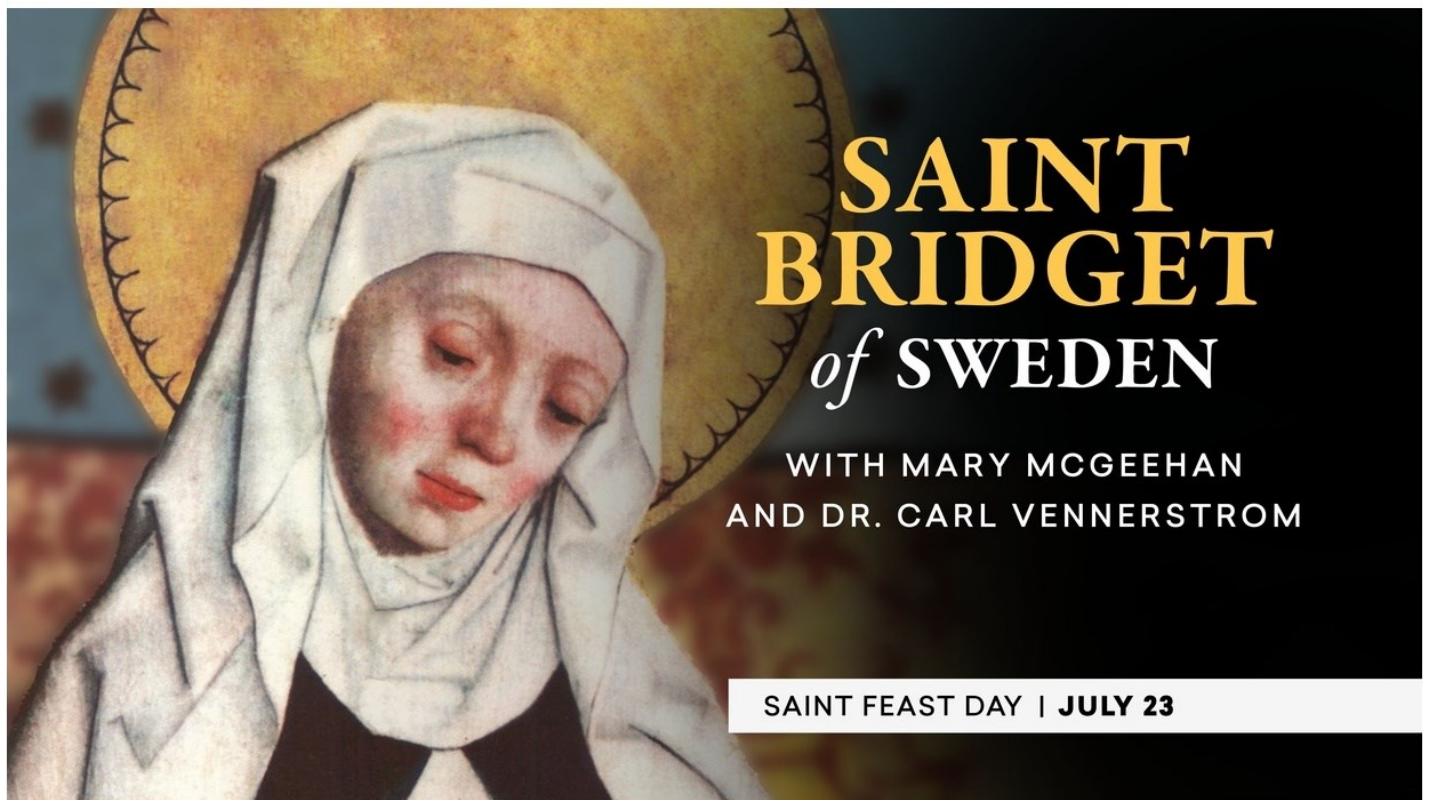
