From the Desk of Fr. Hamness:

Next Sunday is Priesthood Appreciation Sunday. It is the perfect time to think about praying for an increase of vocations to the priesthood. To that end, the Serra Club has printed some pledge sheets which will be distributed in the bulletin today. I am asking you to make a pledge of prayer and/ other sacrifices in order that God would inspire young men in our parish to go to seminary and see if they are called to the priesthood. The pledge sheet asks for Masses, Rosaries, Divine Mercy Chap-lets, Holy Hours, and Fasting to be offered for this intention. I am asking you to take this pledge sheet home and consider what you are willing to pledge. Next Sun-day, at the start of Mass, we will collect the pledges and offer them to God in thanksgiving for the priests we’ve had our whole lives, and in hope of many more priests for the rest of our lives. As a reminder of what you have pledged, tear off the bottom of the pledge sheet to keep for yourself, and turn in just the top por-tion.

And if you are wondering about the Serra Club, it is a nationwide organization with chapters in each diocese that promotes vocations to the priesthood. The Serra Club of the Diocese of Crookston would be happy to have new members from our parish. In Frazee, I think we have two members, and I do not think we have any from Callaway. Please consider joining the Serra Club to be more intentional about praying for the priests we need and working to support the seminarians we already have.

The Serra Club is named after Saint Junipero Serra who established Mission Churches up and down the coast of California in the 1700s.

“No servant can serve two masters. He will hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon (wealth).” LUKE 16:13

Jesus knows that for many of us, God and money run “neck and neck” as top priority. Is money a “god” that you put before God?

Reflection on the Gospel

The complex parable in today’s gospel poses more questions than answers. How can a dishonest steward be praised by his master? Who is the master? Jesus? The rich man? What does “squandering” signify? One possibility for this Sunday is not to try to settle the interpretation of the gospel parable but to look instead at the underlying values and attitudes that the reading propose, which orient us toward good moral decisions in complex situations.

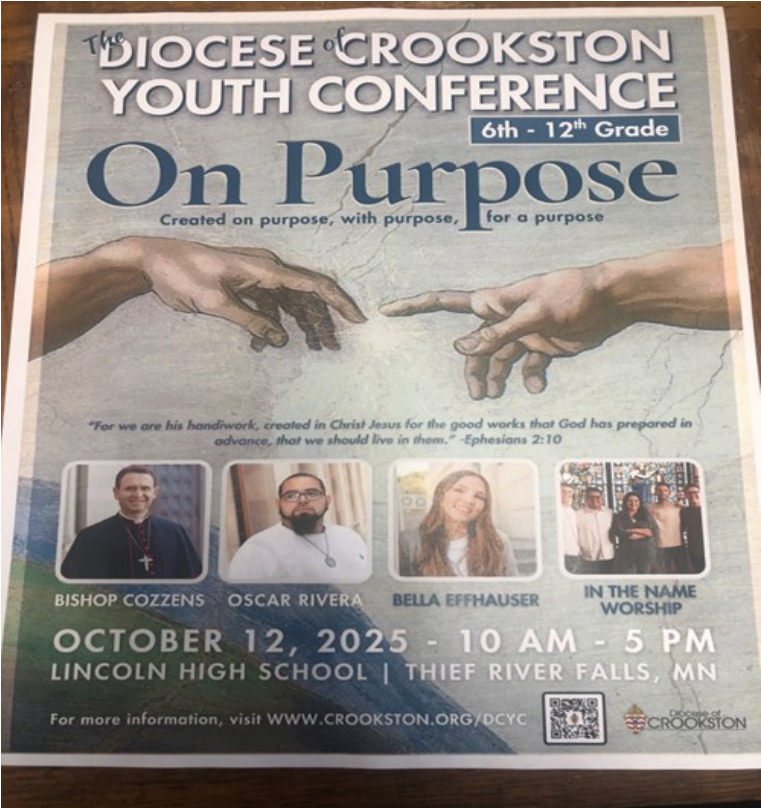
