It ceased for a while, but about 10 years ago, the bishop renewed the directive to publish the marriage banns. Since this practice is new to us once again, do not take it as me being suspicious of the couple whose Banns are published today. Their upcoming wedding is just a suitable time to begin doing what I have been forgetting to do all along. 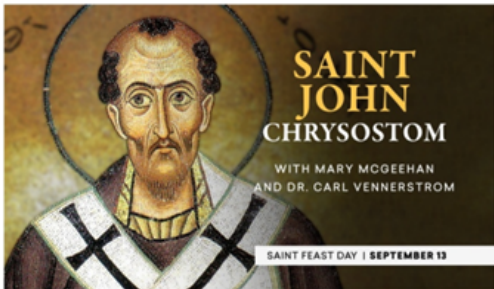
