This coming Thursday marks a historic occasion in the state of Minnesota and the Diocese of Crookston. It is the opening Mass for the Cause for the Canonization of Sister Annella Zervas. A Cause for Canonization is the process in which a holy person's life is studied and proposed to the Pope to see if he would be willing to name the person a Saint. If Sr. Annella is ultimately canonized, she would be the first official Saint from the State of Minnesota, and she grew up in our diocese! I am encouraging everyone to attend the opening Mass and visit the exhibit about her life beforehand. Both are at the Cathedral in Crookston. You can find the details on a flyer inside the bulletin.

I know that the drive may be a little long, so I encourage you to invite some friends to go with you and make a fun evening out of it. Maybe stop for a late night supper at the casino in Mahanomen on your way home???!! Perhaps there is some elderly person that would love to attend but cannot make the drive him or herself. As for me, in my role as Archivist for the Diocese of Crookston, I am more involved than most. I am part of the Historical Commission for this endeavor, and I have been told I am expected to take an oath at the Mass on Thursday night. The following day I have some training with a priest who has flown in from Rome to give us instructions.
