You have probably heard of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major in Rome. It is the oldest church in the Western Roman Empire dedicated to the honor of the Mother of God. The very special feature of this church is a little, sunken alcove underneath the high altar, and within this alcove is a glass and gold reliquary that contains some wooden pieces of the original manger from the stable in Bethlehem in which Jesus was laid after his birth. I am always in awe that significant artifacts like this have been preserved through the centuries so that we can have a tangible connection with the life of Jesus.

Remember that the Christmas Season goes until at least Epiphany on the first Sunday in January, so keep your

decorations up and your trees lit until then; keep celebrating the Lord's birth until the wise men arrive. Don't be an early quitter! Keep saying, "Merry Christmas!"
