I want to remind you about a scam that's been going around again. Some of you have reported getting messages—whether by text, email, or phone—from people pretending to be me. These scammers often ask for gift cards or money, claiming it's for something urgent, like helping someone in the parish or buying supplies for the church. What's especially tricky is that these scams usually seem to happen when I am out of town, which is why I no longer put it in the bulletin if I am going to be away from the parish. The scammers use this to create a sense of urgency, hoping you won't take the time to double-check. Please know that I would *never* ask for financial help or favors like this. If you ever get a request like this, it's not from me. If you're ever unsure about a message, don't hesitate to contact the parish office directly to check. And if you think you've been contacted by a scammer, let us know right away or report it to the authorities.




There will be two Saint John Paul 2 Camps at the Nazareth Retreat Center this summer. The first camp runs July 19-23, and the second runs July 26-30.
